Exposure to music, gentle guidance, and parental modeling allow young children to learn without the anxiety of the expectations of others.

**Parents as Models** Parent or caregiver participation in class activities is strongly encouraged. Proficiency is of no importance. The adult's willingness and enthusiasm are invaluable assets to the group as a whole, and exemplify to the children that joining in is not about "performing," but about having fun. And, by the way, if an Harmonize class isn't fun, really BIG fun, demand your money back.

**About the Director** Alisa Harmon is a professionally trained singer who has been teaching music to children since she was 14. When motherhood altered her career in Banking and her avocation as a performer, she recaptured her love for music education and taught for a national children's music program in Brooklyn. It was there she met David Weinstone, founder of MFA, and music that truly celebrates childhood.

**Registration** Priority registration will begin December 1 and General Registration will begin December 10 when space will be available on a first come, first served basis.
